# 10 COSTLY **ERRORS** EMPLOYEES OFTEN MAKE

- 1) Work for an employer who does not pay for workers' compensation insurance.
- 2) Fail to report an accident immediately.
- 3) Delay, even for one day, obtaining medical evaluation and treatment.
- 4) Fail to complete and submit required workers' compensation forms.
- 5) Agree to an employer's suggestion to overlook an injury.
- 6) Fail to disclose previous injuries or pre-existing medical conditions.
- 7) Misunderstand medical care options.
- 8) Fail to appeal a workers' compensation claim denial.
- 9) Believe an insurance company will be on their side.
- 10) Fail to obtain a consultation with an experienced workers' compensation attorney.
