

# HAS YOUR LAWYER DONE THESE 3 THINGS?

## 01

Your lawyer must go out of his way to “get to the bottom of “YOUR STORY”. If he hasn’t thoroughly interviewed you prior to your hearing... that’s something to watch out for.

## 02

Your lawyer must be touching base with you on a regular basis...I don’t mean just to see how you’re doing. Your lawyer (if he cares about you) should be asking if you’re seeing your doctor and reporting everything. Also, he should be getting job search documentation from you weekly.

These 3 things are what I personally believe a workers’ compensation lawyer **MUST DO** to get you the compensation you deserve.

However- Not every lawyer does...

To me, these are like “THE RULES OF THE ROAD”.

## 03

Your lawyer must be doing whatever is necessary to gather all the paper (especially the medical records) that’s necessary to properly prove your case.

I’m talking evidence here. Records, reports, photos, statements. There’s a lot of plain old hard work involved here. But that’s what it takes.

**Your lawyer needs to ensure  
that your paper trail is TIGHT.**

**WHY?**

Because the injured worker has to **PROVE everything!** The insurance adjuster can sit back and do nothing. You only have one chance to put forth your evidence. You want it to be the best, not mediocre or worse, nonexistent.
